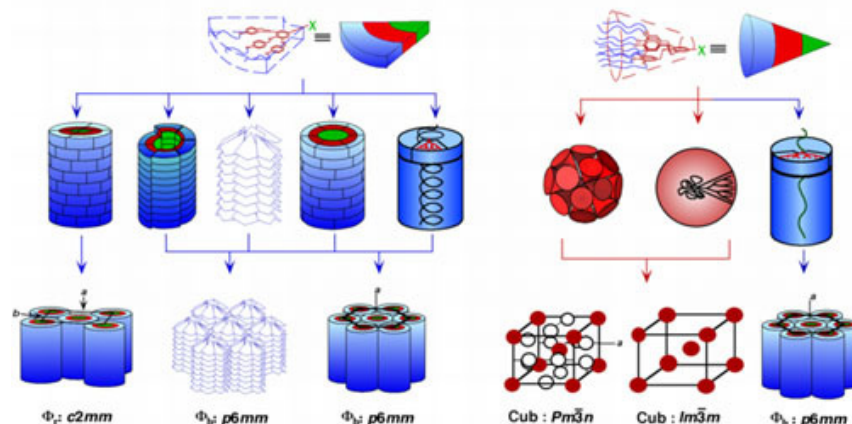
Information on Professor Percec



Professor Percec's research group is involved in the elaboration of synthetic methods, and architectural concepts as well as in the understanding of the fundamental principles that govern the rational design and synthesis of complex molecular, macromolecular and supramolecular nonbiological systems that exhibit biological functions. Biological systems are employed as models to develop the synthetic architectural motifs and to control their self-assembly and self-organization during the creation of ordered systems. His research strikes a balance among a diversity of interrelated disciplines from organic, bioorganic, macromolecular, supramolecular synthesis and catalysis seeking to understand, mimic and extend Nature's solutions to the design of synthetic functional nanosystems.
